This Temporary Class/Type Rating is issued in accordance with ARA.FCL.215(d) and the Standards of ICAO as an extension of a valid airman's licence. It is valid only in connection with the holder's licence and medical certificate.

Valid only if provided aircraft training, including minimum 4 or 6 takeoffs and landings, in accordance to Part FCL Subpart H, is completed under supervision of qualified instructor.

Approved Zero Flight training may substitute the fore-mentioned aircraft training.

For cruise relief co-pilot restriction, practical take-off and landing training after skill test is not required.

In order to process your application we need information about you for identification to secure that the rating/licence is issued/revalidated/renewed to the correct person.
